- 1 Complete prerequisite courses
- 2 Enroll in a nursing program (ADN or BSN)
- 3 Pass the NCLEX-RN exam
- 4 Gain clinical experience as a registered nurse
- 5 Apply to an accredited PMHNP program (MSN or DNP)
- 6 Complete required clinical hours
- 7 Pass board certification (ANCC)
- 8 Obtain state licensure and begin practice
